MEETING OPENED:

The East Fishkill Board of Fire Commissioners held their regular board meeting at district headquarters. Chairman McNamara called the meeting to order at 8:00 P.M.

Commissioner Post made a motion to donate six of the old SCBA packs and bottles to Tivoli. Seconded by Commissioner Dixon. Motion carried. Chief Gallo advised the Board that the Town will be running a water line right past Stormville Fire Department and he would like to ask the Town Supervisor to have a hydrant installed.
